

Welcome! **Moon Lister** (moonlister.com) turns a photo of a trading card into a priced, ready-to-sell listing on **eBay**, **Shopify**, and **Whatnot** in seconds. Snap it, the AI identifies it, checks it against official card catalogs, prices it from real market data, and lists it to your own stores. Raw cards and **graded slabs** (PSA, TAG, CGC...) both work. This guide covers everything you need to get going.

1 Log in

Go to **moonlister.com** and sign in with the username and password your host sent you.

- Works great on your phone — add it to your home screen like an app.
- Need to change your password? **Connections** → **Account** lets you set a new one anytime.

2 Connect your eBay & Shopify

Click **Connections** at the top. This links the app to *your own* stores so cards list under your accounts (never anyone else's).

- **eBay**: click **Connect eBay** → sign in to your eBay → Allow. One click, done.
- **Shopify (optional)**: paste your store domain + an Admin API token — the page shows exactly how to create one. Whatnot rides on Shopify, so connecting Shopify covers Whatnot too.
- **Shipping & location**: enter the ZIP you ship from and your two shipping prices (envelope for cards under \ \$20, bubble mailer for \ \$20+). These go on every eBay listing.
- You only have to do this once.

3 Scan your cards — two ways

■ **Quick Scan (fastest)**: tap the orange **Quick Scan** button, snap or pick photos, and in ~3 seconds each card shows its closest matches — **tap the right one** and the card builds itself with title and price.

■ **Full Scan (hands-free)**: upload front + back photos and the AI identifies, verifies, and prices everything automatically — best for big batches of raw base cards.

- Doing a lot at once? Use **Rapid Scan** to queue many cards, then process them together.
- **Graded slabs** work great — photograph the whole slab with the label sharp. The app reads the label's QR code for an exact cert number, and slabs list on eBay as **Graded** with the grader, grade, and cert filled in automatically.
- Cards the app has seen before are recognized **instantly** — it remembers.

Big batches? Process in comfortable chunks

For the smoothest results, **process every ~30 to 40 cards** rather than stacking up 100+ at once — it keeps each run quick and your credits easy to track. Once processed they're saved and safe, and you just keep shooting the next batch. If the servers are briefly busy during a big run, Moon Lister **automatically retries** any card that hit a busy moment, and re-queues anything left so you never lose a photo — just tap **Process** again to finish. Even better for large runs: shoot in your phone's normal **Camera app first** (those auto-save), then in the app tap upload → Photo Library and select them — front/back pair up by photo order, and you get camera-roll backups too.

Your test credits

You start with a set amount of **test credits** (shown at the top). Scanning uses a tiny bit of credit per card — roughly a penny or two. Listing, pushing to Shopify, re-picking matches, and exports don't use scan credits. Running low? Ask your host for a top-up.

Review flagged cards

Most cards are ready instantly. A few get an **amber “Held for review” banner** — cards the app wants you to double-check before listing (a serial-numbered /25 card, a hard-to-read card, or a possible name mismatch).

- ■ **“Did you mean?”** — held cards often show the closest matches. Tap the right one and the card fixes itself (free, instant).
- Or fix anything with **Edit** (clears the hold), hit ■ **Rescan** to re-run the AI, or tap **“Looks right — release”**.
- **“Price check”** holds show two prices that disagreed (eBay comps vs. catalog market data) — glance, pick the right one, release.
- Held cards won't list until you okay them — this keeps you from selling a \$120 card for \$5.

List & sell

Check the cards you want, then use the **List Cards** ■ button (top left). It's a menu — pick where to send them:

- **List on eBay** — Buy It Now or Auction.
- **Push to Shopify** — also makes them live on Whatnot; you choose which sales channels.
- ■ **Push to All** — lists to **eBay and Shopify in one go**. Great for cross-listing a whole batch at once.

When a card sells, the app automatically pulls it from your other channels so you never sell the same card twice. (You can also hit **Sync Sales** anytime.)

Export a spreadsheet — the CSV / Inventory Sheet menu

Under **Tools**, the ■ **CSV / Inventory Sheet** ■ button gives you three downloads: an **Inventory Sheet** — a clean, readable list of your whole collection with a total value, perfect for handing a vendor or another collector to sell in bulk; an **eBay bulk-upload CSV**; and a **TCGPlayer CSV** for trading-card games. The inventory sheet automatically leaves out empty placeholder rows so it stays clean.

Handy tools (under the Tools bar)

■ **Sync Sales** checks eBay + Shopify for sales and delists the other channels. ■ **Audit Listings** re-checks your live listing titles against the card photos and flags anything that looks off. ■ **Reprice Audit** re-prices your active eBay listings with today's market data and fixes stale prices in place.

Tips for the best results

Good light, card flat and filling the frame, no glare. Shoot **both sides**. The clearer the photo, the better the ID and price — blurry or angled shots are the #1 cause of a wrong read.

What feedback helps most

You're here to break it — please do! Tell your host about: **wrong titles or prices**, anything **confusing**, anything **slow or broken**, and especially anything that shows the **wrong account's info**. Every wrong card you flag makes the app smarter for everyone.
